What is Hogar de Vida?

Established in 1992 in Guatemala and 1995 in Costa Rica. Homes of Life (Hogar de Vida in Spanish) is a Christian ministry in Latin America that exists to serve the needs of at-risk children in <u>Costa Rica</u> and <u>Guatemala</u>. The missionary work of each home has its own unique objectives. However, both homes return abundant blessings to the children being cared for.

Tim and Dena's vision for love, support and passion for the Kingdom of God and the care for God's children is being realized in both special homes. The founders Tim and Dena Stromstad, along with dedicated staff and volunteers, minister to the precious children at risk and provide a safe, nurturing place to learn about God's love for them in Christ.

Many children arrive completely destitute, without a family's care or basic provisions that many people take for granted. Often the victims of abuse or neglect, the children's needs are met by the patience and hard work of caring men and women as well as through your support.

A nurturing Christian home and family system that give children from families in crisis the tools they need for a brighter future. Our goal is to protect and love them for the period the children are in our care. Most importantly we provide an opportunity to know Jesus and receive His love.

Our homes...

• Costa Rica - Hogar de Vida currently houses up to 35 children at any given time. The three homes on the property provide a secure environment, clothing, nutrition, education, parental figures. We have a paid psychologist, nurses, teachers, a director, human resources, secretary as well as 40+ paid staff including early childhood caregivers and maintenance workers providing 24/7 365 care. Our children will be healed in heart and formed for service.

Project Description: needs and impact

- This year, in 2023, we made a commitment to develop an Advisory Outreach team to build a sustainable outreach and funding sources team to ensure Tim and Dena's vision for love, support and passion for the Kingdom of God and the care for God's children would be realized well into the future.
- Costs have rising sharply over the last four years with new government requirements, licensing, caretaker ratios, the overall cost of employees and general inflation. We are facing budget short falls; our expenses are greater than our income. COVID-19 took fund raising to near zero, as most of our funding was done by the support of teams visiting. In 2020 we had 0 teams and 2021 just 4. We need to diversify with the expansion of critical fund-raising efforts.

Needs	Description	
Milk Project	Currently, Hogar de Vida in Guatemala supports eight needy families who have babies in the San Andreas area. These families are supplied with eight months of formula and nutritional support and for three additional months as babies transition to solid foods. We are also able to teach them about Jesus's love for them. We need financial support to maintain and expand this beneficial family project. With additional financial support we would be able to serve more families.	
Food Baskets and Family Support	Currently, Hogar de Vida blesses ten families with school-aged children with food and school supplies once a month. The basic food and nutritional information that they receive is not quite enough to completely sustain the family but rather to help them learn how to feed and support themselves. This comes from the theology of "teaching people to fish" as opposed to giving them all the fish that they need. These families also receive basic school supplies, so the children are able to attend school. The parents are responsible for ensuring that their children are attending school clean, with appropriate hygiene and with their homework completed. Throughout this program, Hogar de Vida is given opportunities to feed families both nutritionally and spiritually. With additional financial support, we would be able to expand this program to include more needy families.	
School Support	Hogar de Vida works closely with some of the elementary schools in the surrounding villages. Since the Guatemalan government does not provide school supplies, Hogar de Vida gives them items such as crayons, notebooks, pens, pencils, glue, markers, paper, even photocopying and teaching materials. Additional funds would allow us to expand this program to further equip the schools that we already are involved with or support even more schools.
